2. Aspects of public international law relating to the pipeline Nord Stream 2.
3. Aspects of EU law relating to the pipeline Nord Stream 2, in particular the EU's Third Energy Package.
4. Administrative planning procedures relating to the pipeline Nord Stream 2.
5. Issues of conflict laws relating to the pipeline Nord Stream 2.
6. International jurisdiction for possible disputes arising out of the construction or use of the pipeline.
7. Contractual structures relating to the construction or use of the pipeline.
8. Contents and legality of U.S. sanctions against the construction of the pipeline; legal response by the EU.
9. Alternative dispute resolution in complex international construction projects (at the example of the planned gas pipeline Nord Stream 2).
10. Further topics can be chosen in case of specific interest.
